



LOCAL CONTRACTOR HITS £50M TURNOVER

Hall Construction Services Ltd, based in Co. Durham, has achieved a turnover of £50m in the year to January 2007.

Hall Construction has just completed the £11.5m contract for a new 10,000 seater stadium for Shrewsbury Town FC which has now been handed over in readiness for the start of the new season.

The company continues its successful track record in new sports stadia as it is currently building the new £17.5m Leigh Sports Village Stadium, near Wigan.

Locally, the company has recently won a number of industrial projects and has just started on site with its second contract, worth £3m, for Easter Group to design and build 10 new industrial units at Riverside Park, Middlesbrough.

Also on Riverside Park work continues on the £6m redevelopment of transport workshops & offices for Bulkhaul Ltd.

Work is well underway on a new industrial facility and offices at Stokesley for Armstrong Richardson and a new £2m four storey storage warehouse at Wallsend for Safestore Ltd.

Further civils work is being carried out at Teesport for PD Teesport and a major £7.5m infrastructure & earthworks contract is on site at Hatfield, near Doncaster for Powerfuel Ltd in preparation for a new power station.

Recently completed projects include the new autocentre and display compounds at Thornaby for Alexanders Saab, a new soil washing facility at Port Clarence for Augean plc and Hall's second contract for Evans Easyspace on their new business centre at Newton Aycliffe, where it will shortly commence on a further phase subject to planning.

In addition, Hall Construction has recently opened an office in the Scottish Borders following its appointment on 2 major civil engineering contracts at Airdrie for Woodford Environmental and at Riddochill, West Lothian in partnership with Waystone Developments Ltd.
