The cubes have landed at Middlehaven

THE future is taking shape at Middlehaven, Middlesbrough this week with the arrival of the first futuristic cube structures.

The buildings are being lowered into place today (Thurs, October 18) by crane and will form developer BioRegional Quintain's marketing suite and show apartment.

Hall Construction Services Ltd has been awarded the main contract on a design/build basis and the completed £350,000 suite, due to open later this year, will give a further insight into what life will be like at the ground-breaking £200m development.

Middlehaven is the UK's most environmentally friendly mixed-use project and is one of a number of major schemes spearheaded by Tees Valley Regeneration.

In keeping with Middlehaven's environmental ethos, the marketing suite will embody a number of sustainable features.

It is designed to be demountable and so can easily be reused. Heat pumps will provide heating to the building, using the outside air as a heat source and all electricity will be 100% renewable. The equipment and finishes in the suite will be environmentally friendly.
